







Lady Judges of Pakistan is a documentary-film focusing on the legal proceedings in the law courts presided over by women judges in the four provinces of Pakistan. Shot in observational style and developed on the basis of collaborative relationships, it weaves together court proceedings, personal narratives, and glimpses of everyday life. While the main action flows through the multi-sited management of justice, interactions among litigants, defendants, lawyers, clerks, police and the large public offer insights in the socio-legal context that the women judges are grappling with in Pakistan.
